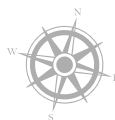

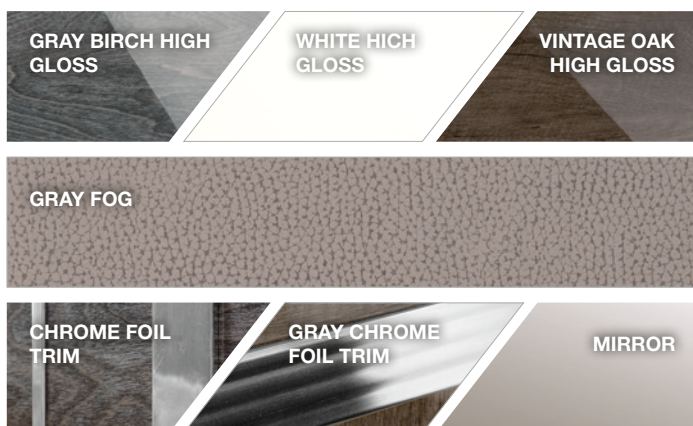

VIVENTE COLLECTION MATERIAL GUIDE



All products from the Vivente Collection are 100% Made in Italy. The materials used in the manufacturing process are sourced from certified suppliers complying with European safety and durability regulations. Vivente products are made with materials that are completely non-toxic and do not contain substances that are harmful to human health and to the environment. Products made with glass are safety tempered. Padding and upholstery materials are flame-retardant. Avoid excessive exposure to direct sunlight in order to prevent prompt aging of the furniture and color tone variation. Protect furniture from high temperatures or humidity both in transportation and in the area in which it is installed. Do not drag objects through the surface; always lift objects. Avoid placing glasses or cups directly on the surface. Cold, wet, or hot drink containers can damage the finish and leave stains. If liquids are accidentally spilled on a surface, immediately wipe with a damp cloth, and later dry it with a soft lint-free cloth.

Care & Maintenance:

Fabrics & Eco-Leather

Clean eco-leather and microfiber surfaces with a soft dry cloth, being careful not to rub excessively to avoid damaging the material. Do not use cleaning products under any circumstances.

Hard Surfaces

In the case of stains, we recommend the use of pure water or mild liquid detergent (neutral PH soap) or refer to a professional according to the table below:

In order to protect the surfaces, do not use powder detergent, abrasive products, bleach or highly chlorinated substances, acids and strong bases. Avoid spraying products directly on the surface because this can leave stain rings, but rather apply the detergent on a damp soft cloth, and then clean and rinse. For smooth or slightly embossed surfaces, make a preliminary cleaning with a soft cloth using the detergents of the above table. If this cleaning does not sufficiently remove the dirt from the deepest veins of the embossing, treat the affected area with a melamine sponge that has been slightly dampened with warm water.

Cleaning instructions are not valid for persistent or dried stains: the dirt must be cleaned immediately. *Essentials For Living is not responsible for any stains or wear and tear on fabrics.
